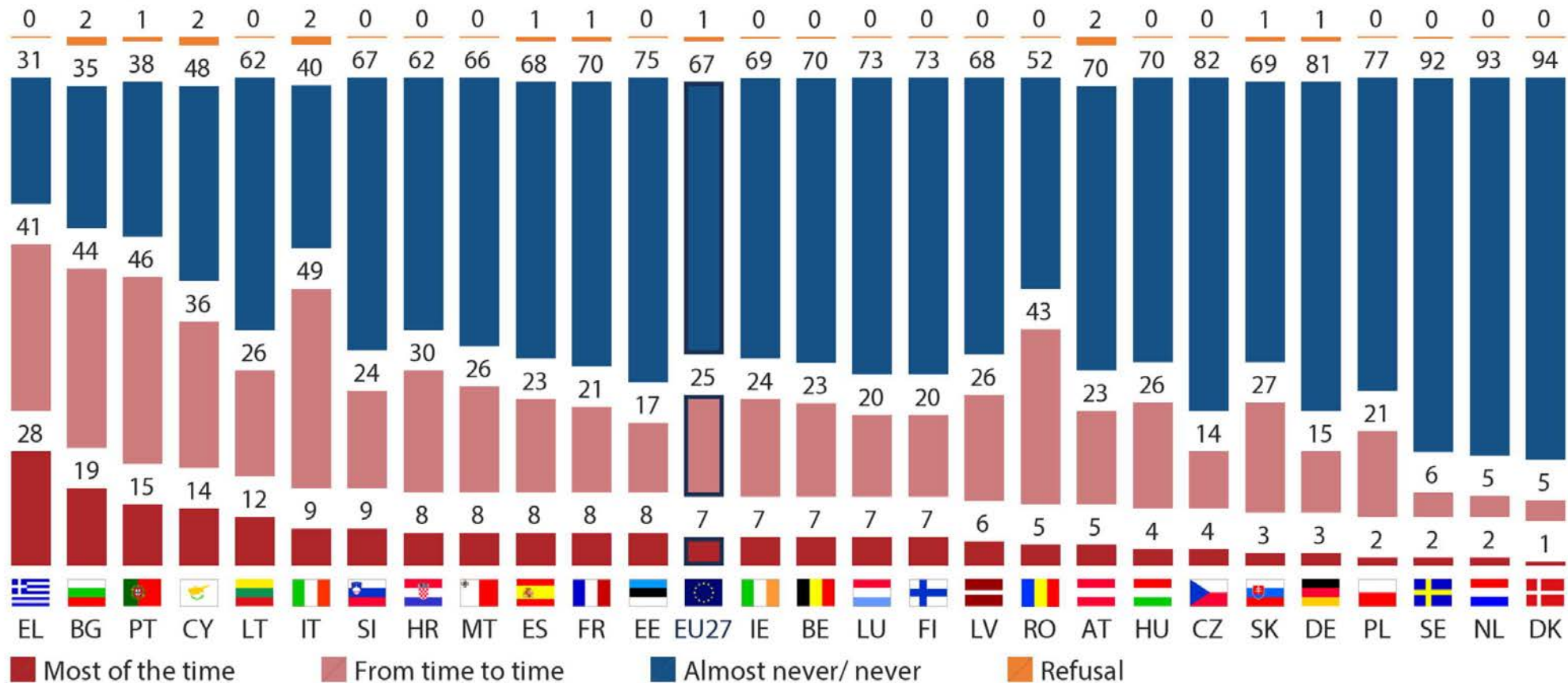

Tough economic situation: Portugal is of the 4 EU countries (with EL, BG and IT) where more than one half of the citizens (PT 61%) say they have difficulties paying their bills.

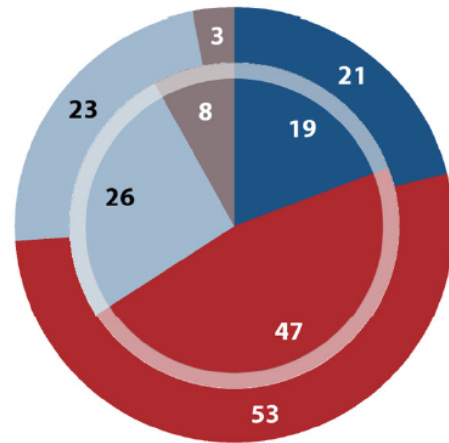
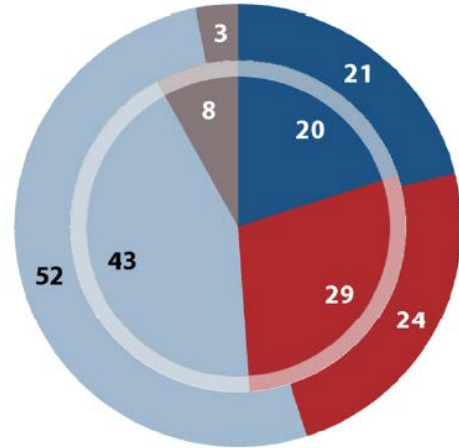
SD10 During the last twelve months, would you say you had difficulties to pay your bills at the end of the month...?

52% say their living conditions will remain the same, 53% say their country's economy will be worse off in twelve months.

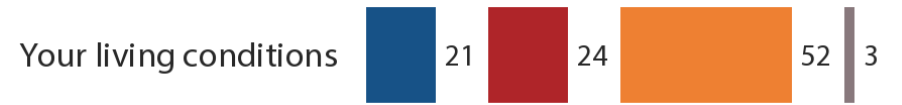
Portuguese respondents are slightly less pessimistic

SD20 In one year's time, do you think that each of the following will be better, worse, or the same as today? (% - EU)

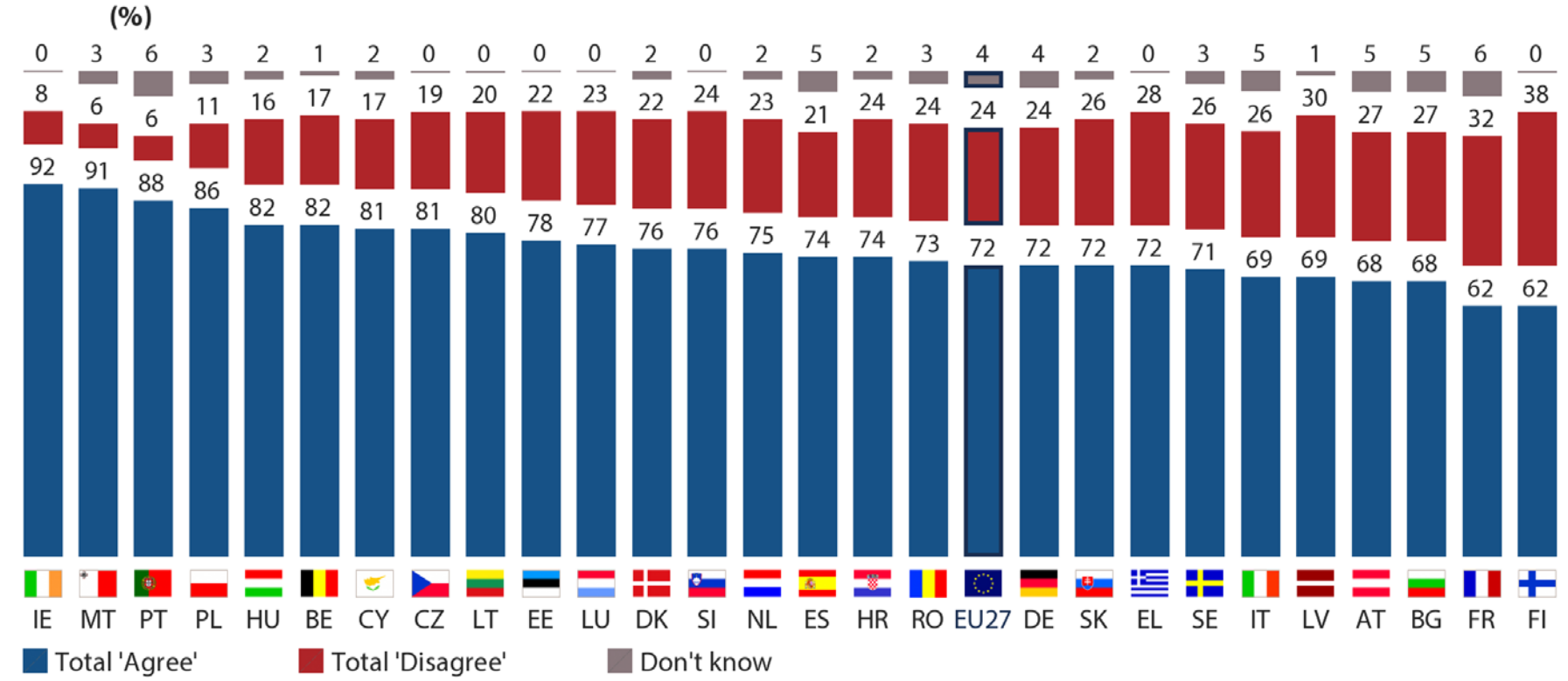

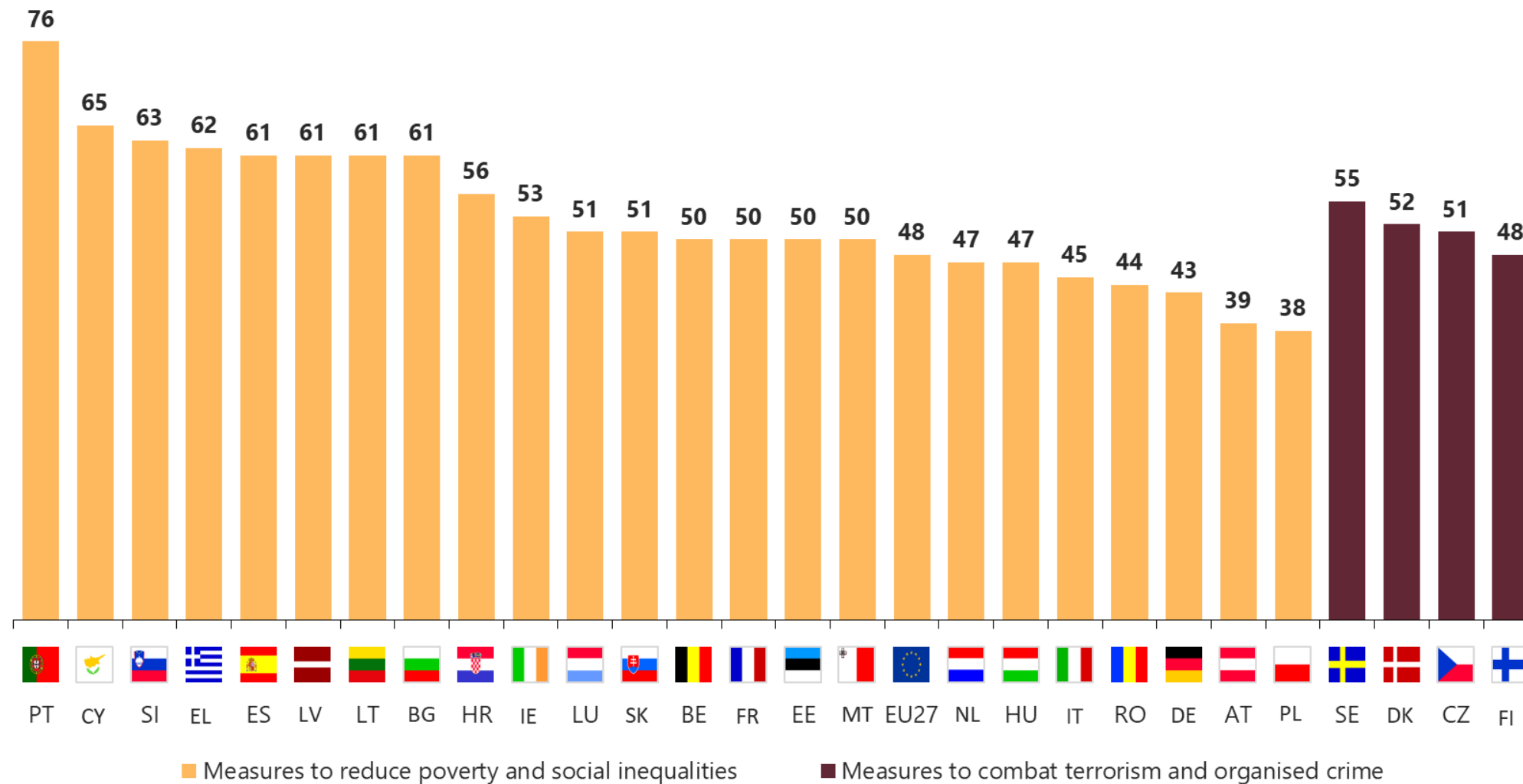
In all countries, more than six out of ten respondents agree that the recovery plan of the EU will allow their country's economy to recover more rapidly from the pandemic

Measures to reduce poverty and social inequalities as the main priority of the European Parliament is the top answer in 23 countries



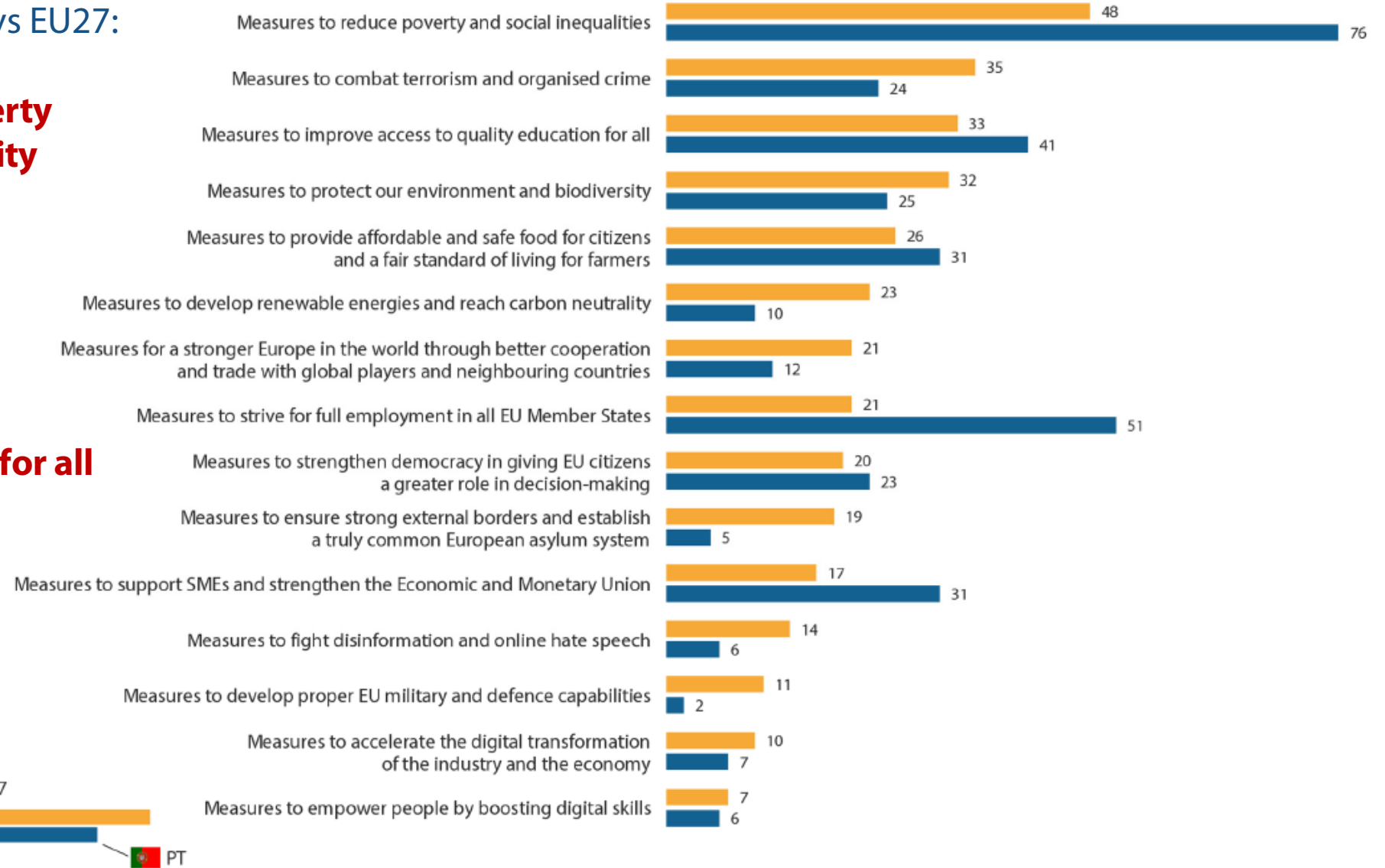

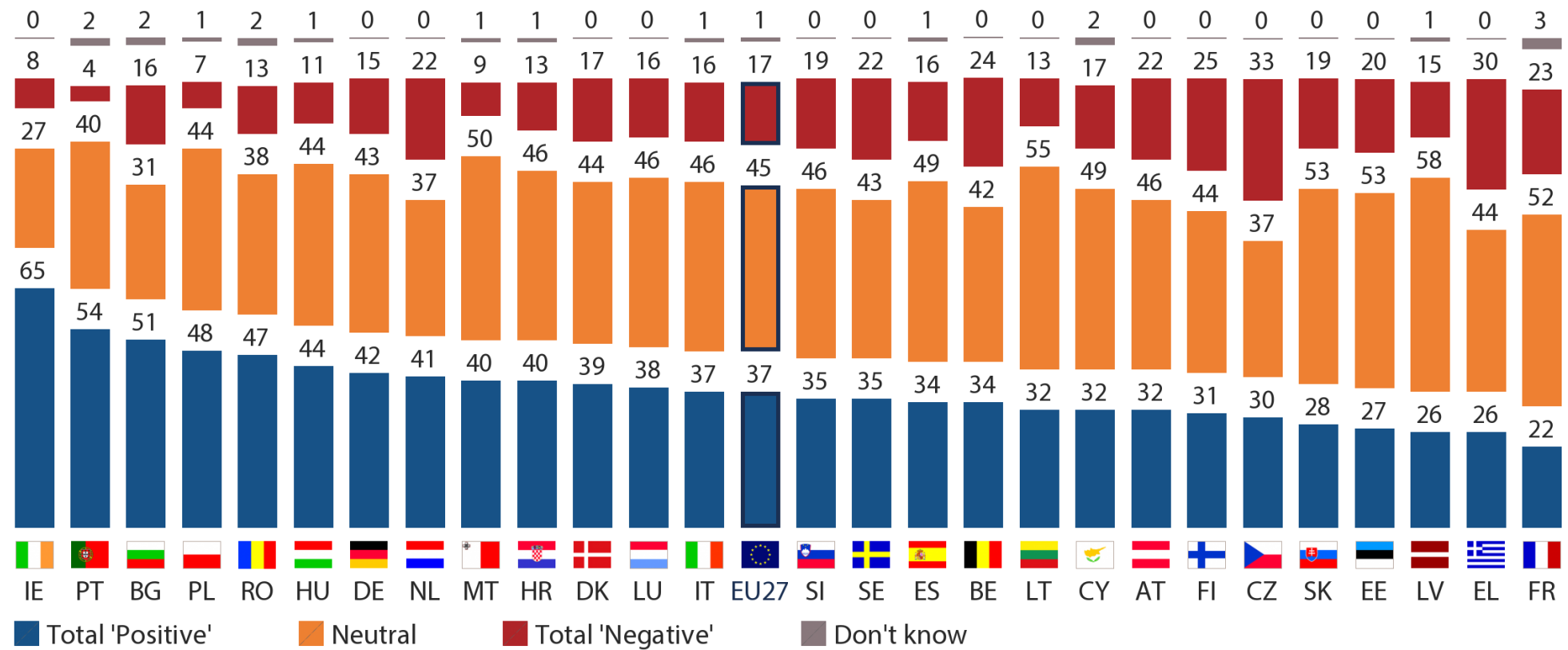

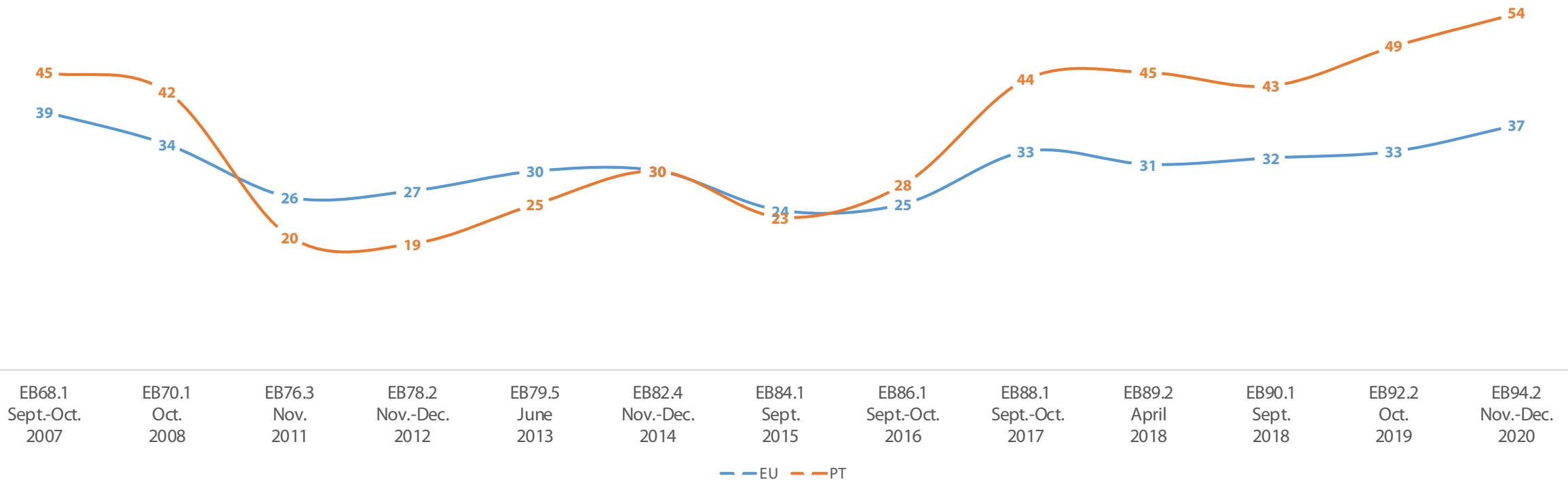

Image of the European Parliament

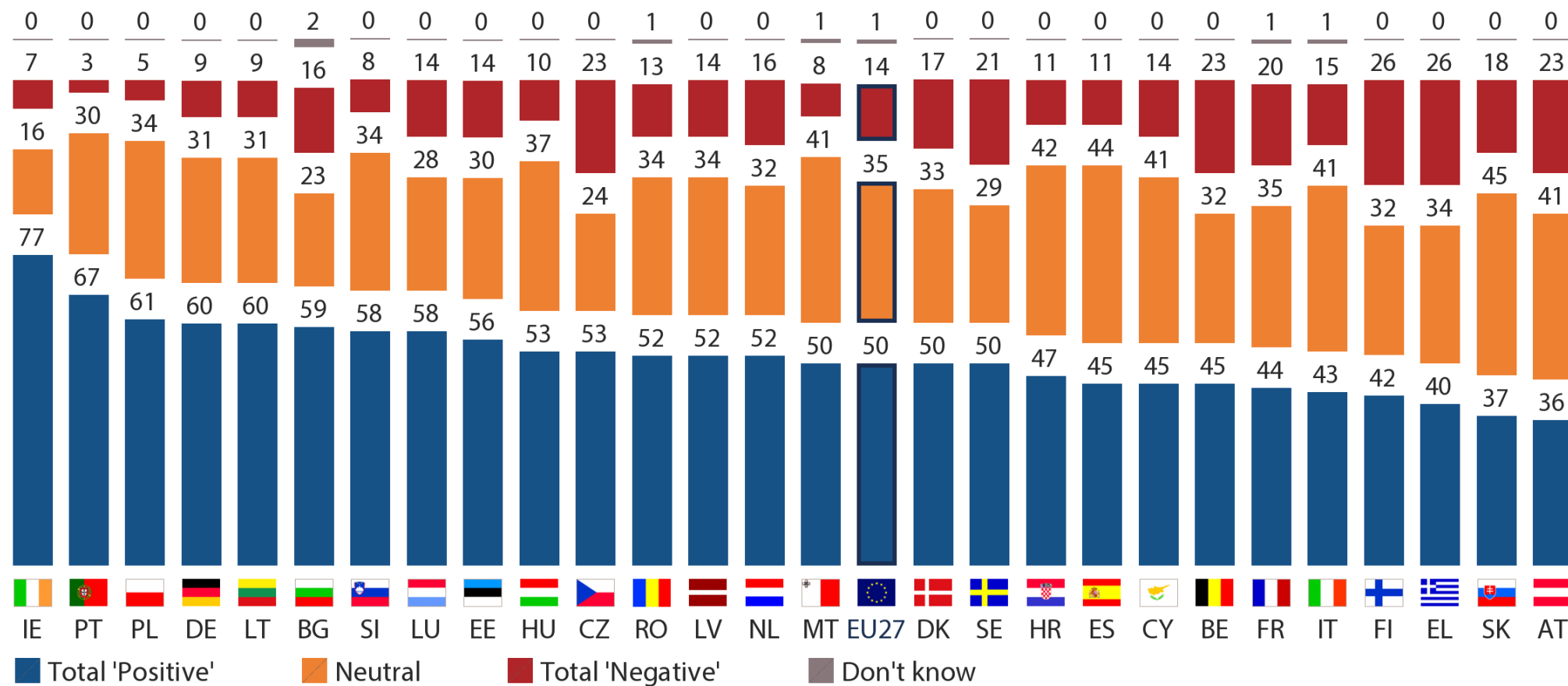


In general, does the European Parliament conjure up for you a very positive, fairly positive, neutral, fairly negative or very negative image?

The survey finds a majority of respondents holding a positive image of the EU in 25 countries

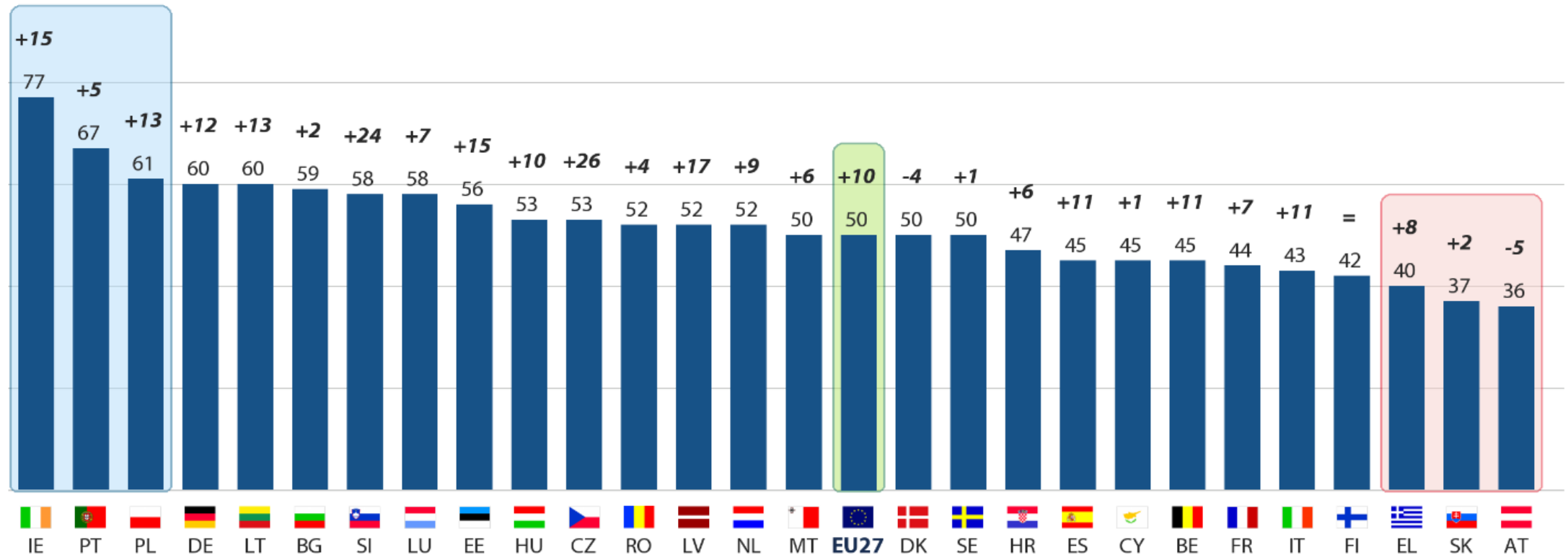

Portugal comes out with the second most positive image of the EU: 67%

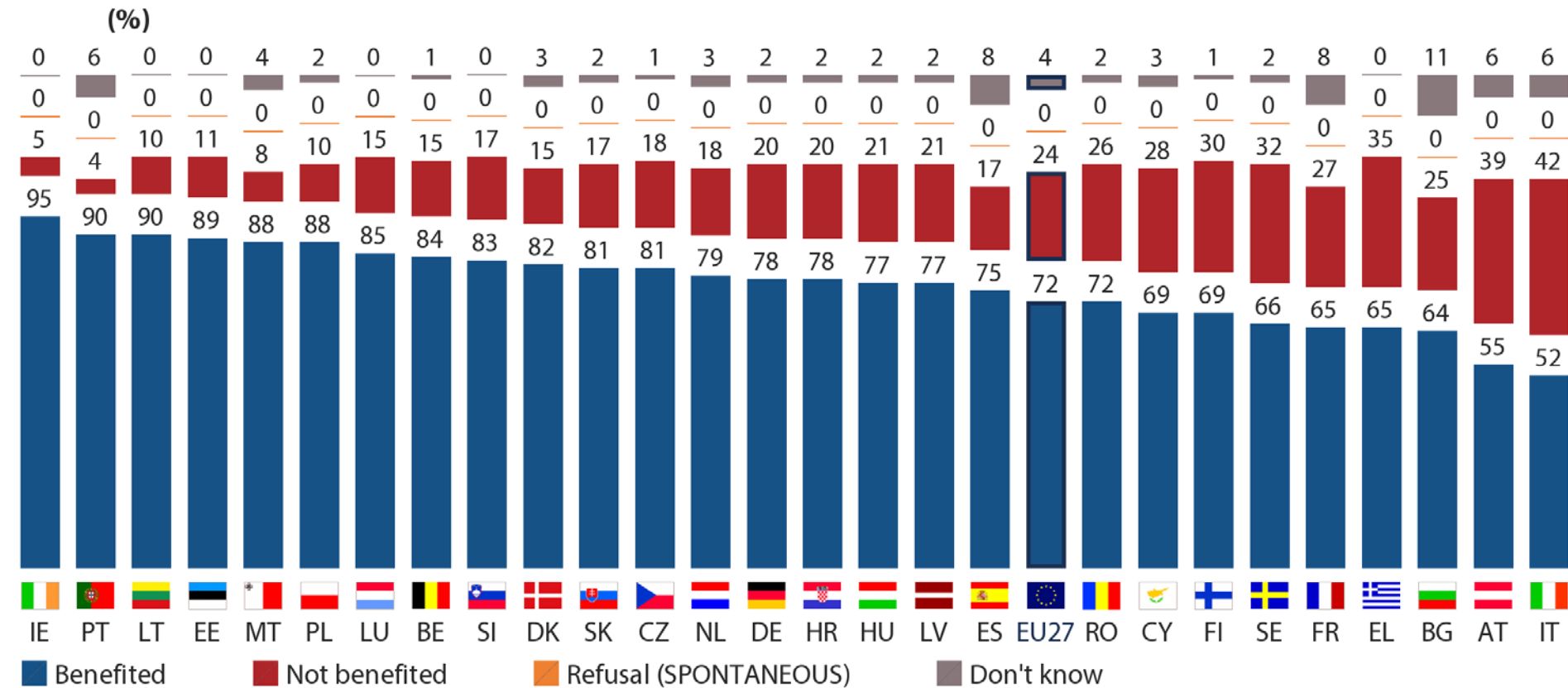

QA10 Taking everything into account, would you say that (OUR COUNTRY) has on balance benefited or not from being a member of the EU?

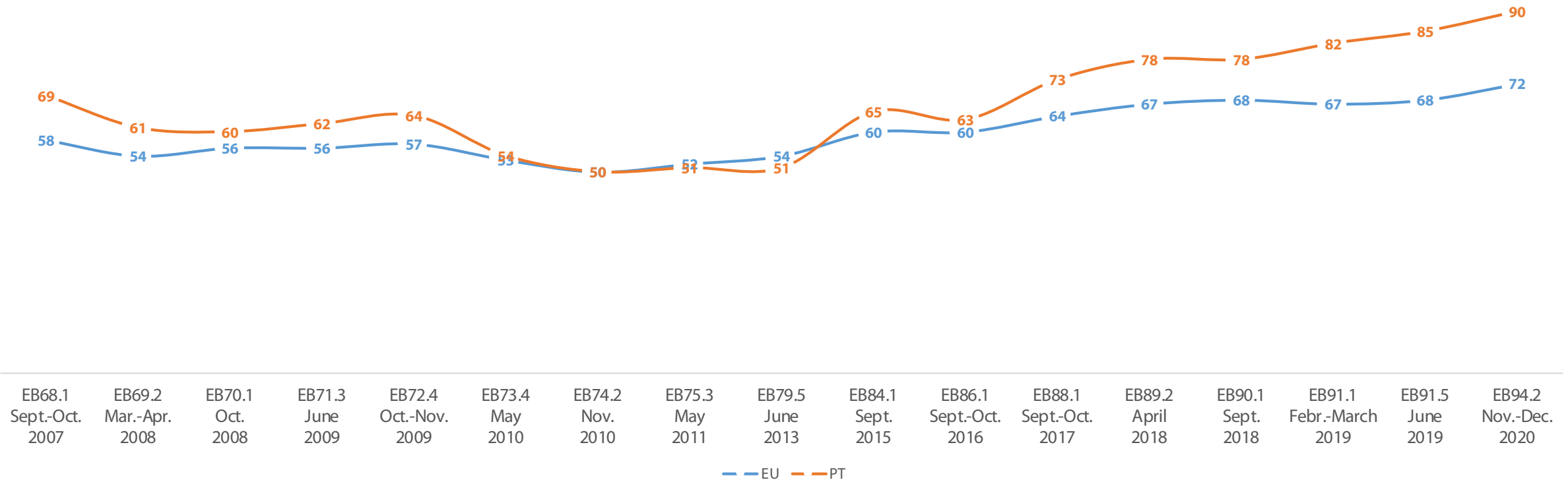

Benefited from the EU Membership

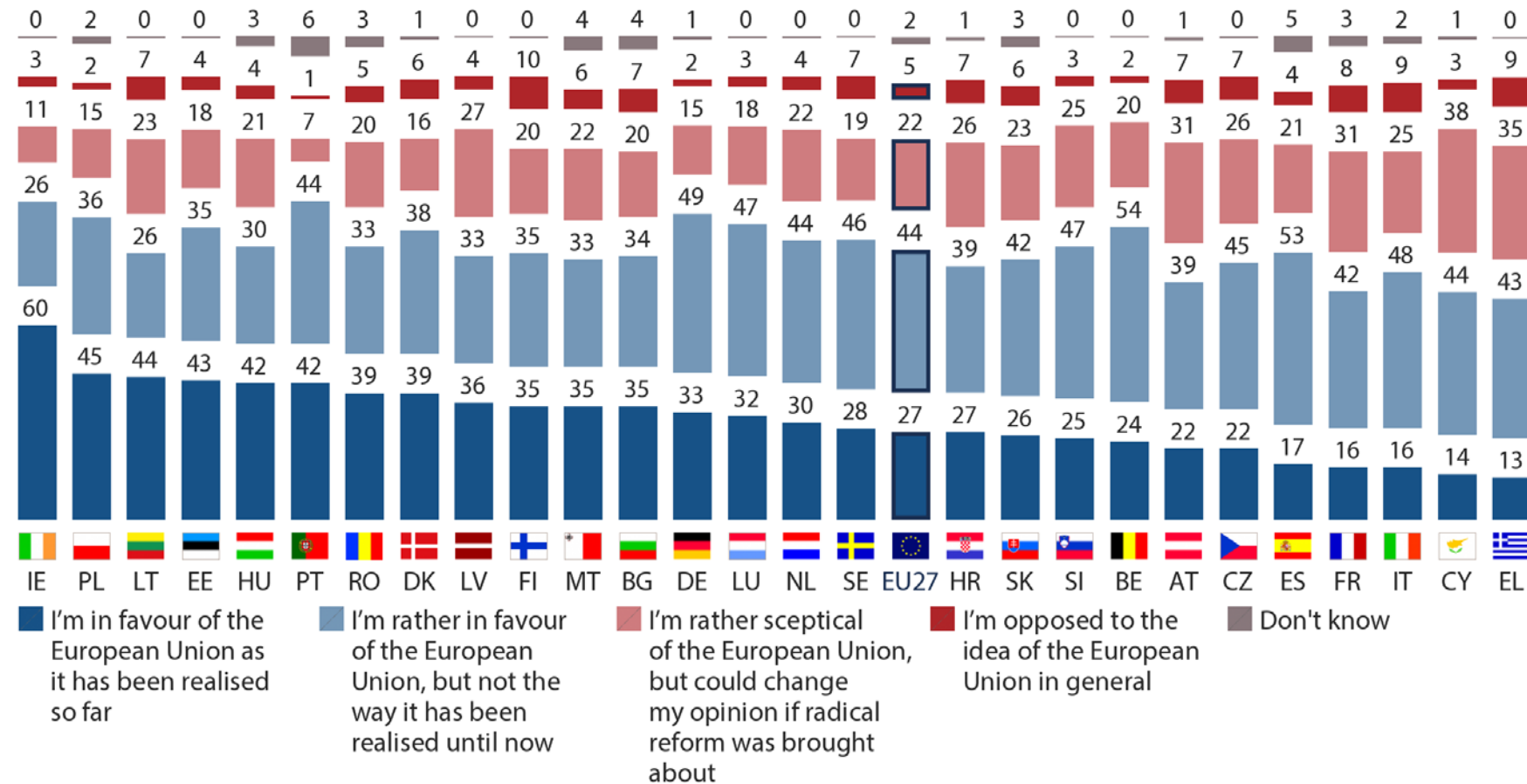


Taking everything into account, would you say that Portugal has on balance benefited or not from being a member of the EU?

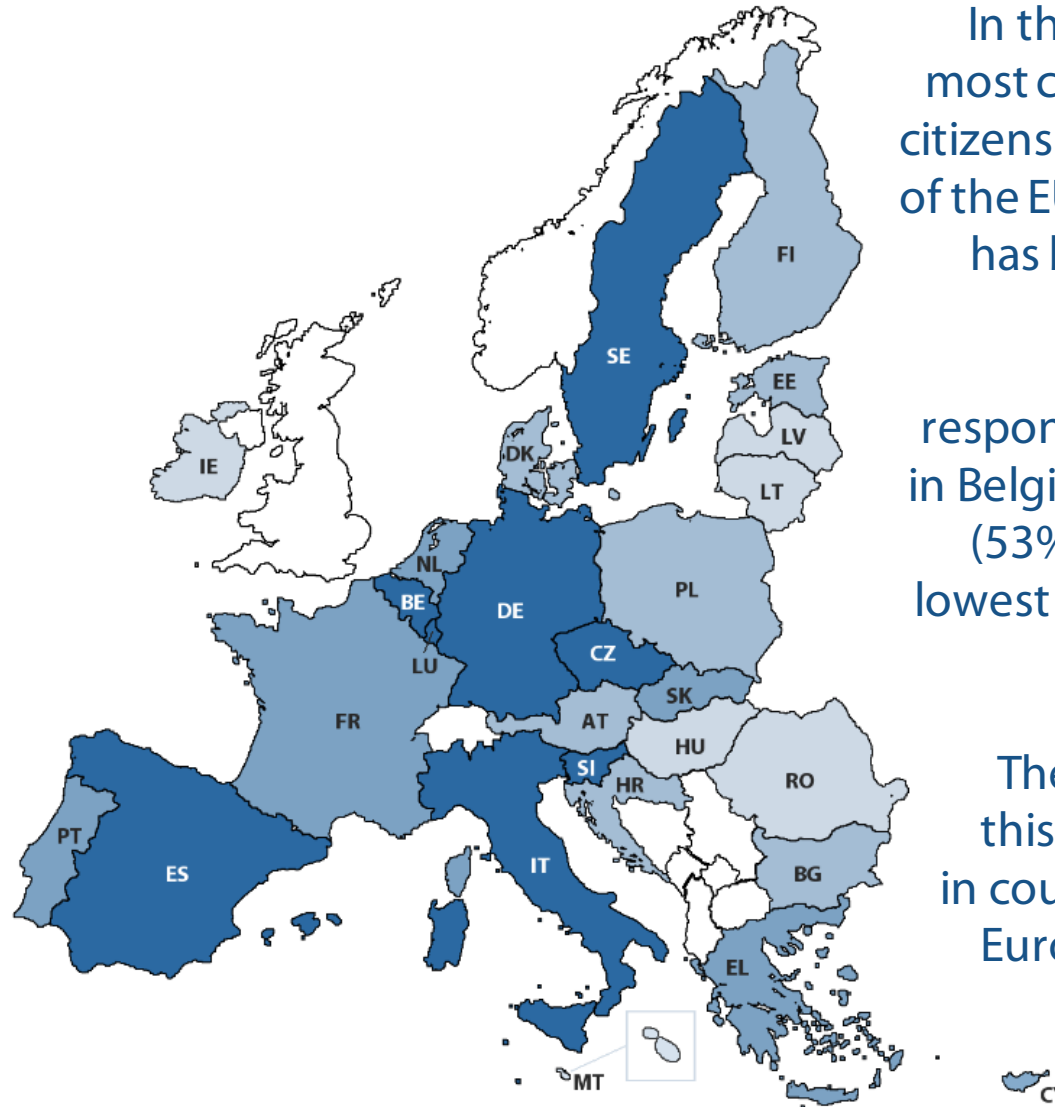

In the EU as a whole, the most common view is that citizens are 'rather in favour of the EU, but not the way it has been realised so far'.

More than half of respondents take this view in Belgium (54%) and Spain (53%). This proportion is lowest in Ireland (26%) and Lithuania (26%).

There is a tendency for this view to be stronger in countries in the west of Europe than in the east.
